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Turkey, Vietnam Sign Investment Deal



Turkey and Vietnam have signed an investment agreement aimed at boosting economic ties, Turkey's Economy Minister Nihat ZEYBEKCİ said at the 6th Period Meeting of Turkey-Vietnam Joint Economic Commission. The agreement is focused on direct investments in capital, technology, and know-how. ZEYBEKCİ noted that Turkey and Vietnam share many common values and the

bilateral economic relations between two countries developed significantly over the last decade. The trade volume between the two countries increased from USD 63 million in 2002 to USD 1.3 billion in 2012. ZEYBEKCİ pointed out potential investment sectors for Turkish investors including manufacturing, education, health, energy, renewable energy and tourism. Vietnam's Industry and Trade Minister Vu Huy HOANG also praised Turkey as an important partner.

Turkey's Textile Exports Up 7 Percent



Turkey's revenue from textiles and raw materials exports, excluding apparel, has risen by 7 percent since 2013, according to the data released by the Istanbul Textile and Apparel Exporters' Association (ITKIB) and Turkey Exporters Assembly (TIM). The data shows that the sector's exports reached USD 8.3 billion in 2013. The country exports more than USD 3.8 billion-worth of textile products to European countries. The main importing countries for Turkey's textile and raw materials are Russia, Italy, and Romania, worth USD 1.16 billion, US\$837 million, and USD 329 million, respectively. The data also shows that the exports to Middle Eastern countries also increased by 6.2 percent, reaching USD 663 million in the last year.

Machinery Exports From Turkey To Germany Reach \$2.16bn

Turkey's machinery exports to Germany, the country with the strongest machinery and equipment industry in Europe, rose by 5.6 percent to USD 2.16 billion in 2013 from USD 2.05 billion in 2012. According to data from Turkey's Machinery and Accessories Exporters Union (MAIB), machinery exports grew faster than Turkey's total exports. Meanwhile, the country's total machine exports also increased by 8 percent in 2013, to USD 13.99 billion, compared to about USD 12.96 billion in the 2012. Turkey aims to export USD 16 billion worth of machinery - a 15 percent increase in overall export of such items - by the end of 2014, said Adnan Dalgakiran, MAIB's executive board chairman. Following Germany, the countries where Turkey exported most of its machinery products in 2013 were United Kingdom with USD 921 million, US with USD 823 million, Russia with USD 769 million and Irag with USD 697 million. France and Italy followed with USD 572 million and USD 518 million, respectively, data showed. Germany, US, China, Japan and Italy are the leading machinery suppliers, and these five countries control 51 percent of the world machinery market. According to the Turkish Statistical Institute (TurkStat), Turkey's total export volume was USD 151.7 billion in 2013.
