Myanmar Chief Ministers for Yangon Region and Mandalay Region, H.E. U Myint Swe and H.E. U Ye Myint led the Myanmar delegation for WATEC Israel 2013 – "Water Technology and Environmental Control Exhibition & Conference", which took place between October 22-24, 2013 at the Israel Trade Fairs and Convention Center Tel-Aviv, Israel.

During their visit in the exhibition, they joined numerous meetings and functions with a large number of Israeli companies, including a lunch hosted by H.E. Naftali Bennet, Minister of Economy and H.E Silvan Shalom, Minister for Regional Development, Energy and Water Resources.

This visit of the two Chief Ministers, takes place during the 60th anniversary of the establishment of the diplomatic relations between the State of Israel and the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, and is the first high-ranking official visit from Myanmar to Israel in 20 years.
