Turkish Economy Minister Calls for More Investments in Turkmenistan

Turkish Economy Minister Zafer ÇAĞLAYAN said that Turkish businessmen should increase and diversify their investments in Turkmenistan. Meanwhile, Turkmen Ambassador Ata SERDAROV said that around 600 Turkish companies operating in Turkmenistan contributed very well in Turkmenistan's economic development.

Fourteen Turkish Provinces Exceed \$1 Bln in Exports

Fourteen Turkish provinces made over a billion Dollars worth of exports each in the first ten months of 2013, according to the data of Turkish Exporters' Assembly (TIM). Turkey's Istanbul province has made \$52.21 billion worth of exports, accounting for around 42% of total Turkish exports in ten months as Turkish exports hit 124,35 billion Dollars in the January-October 2013 period. Bursa province with \$10.67 billion and Kocaeli province with \$10.56 billion took the second and third place respectively and have made over \$10 billion dollars of exports in the first ten months of 2013. Turkish capital Ankara ranked fourth with \$5.89 billion worth of exports after Izmir with \$7.29 billion in exports in 10 months.

Turkey's Economy Ministry Agrees to Free Trade Zone

The Economy Ministry of Turkey penned a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in cooperation with the Ras Al Khaimah Free Trade Zone (RAK FTZ), one of the fastestgrowing and most cost-effective free trade zones in the United Arab Emirates (UAE). Deputy Undersecretary of Turkish Ministry of Economy Bülent Uğur ECEVİT and RAK FTZ Chairman Sheikh Ahmad Saqer Mohamed AL-QASIMI penned the MoU at a ceremony, which was held in Ras Al Khaimah. AL-QASIMI said that Turkey has been a very important and strategic market for RAK FTZ and its clients, and he added, "We discussed a wide range of opportunities for closer business relations and have agreed on multiple areas of mutually beneficial cooperation." Pointing out the cooperation MoU between Turkey and Ras Al Khaimah, ECEVIT said that this MoU would open up new avenues for cooperation, launch joint projects and provide business and networking opportunities for the business clients in Turkey.

Turkish-Canadian FTA Talks Expected After CETA

After the European Union and Canada unveiled their multi-billion Dollar Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA) on Oct. 18, Turkey, which has had a customs union with the EU since 1996, expects to start formal negotiations for a Free Trade Agreement (FTA) with Canada. Veysel Parlak, the Deputy Director-General of the EU Department in the Turkish Ministry of Finance, told that Turkey is hoping for a green light from Canada to begin formal negotiations, especially after Canada reached a significant trade agreement with the EU.

Turkey, Sudan Ink Economic Cooperation Protocol

Turkey and Sudan signed an economic cooperation protocol after the two-day talks between the agriculture ministers of the two countries. Turkish Agricultural Minister Mehdi EKER and his visiting Sudanese counterpart Halim Ismail AL-MUTAAFI inked the Joint Economic Committee 3th Term Summit (JEC) protocol in Khartoum in a bid to boost economic relations. Sudan is the 11th largest trade partner for Turkey in Africa and 6th among the Sub-Saharan countries by 2012, according to figures released by the Turkish government. "We want to raise the trade volume between Turkey and Sudan to a much higher level than it currently stands," EKER said in a statement released by the Turkish Ministry of Agriculture. Turkey managed to achieve a 5.2 percent economic growth despite the negative effects of regional and global developments, EKER said. Turkey aims to become one of the 10 largest economies in the world by 2023, with gross domestic product of 2 trillion U.S. dollars, EKER added. AL-MUTAAFI said his country wants to see the Turkish private sector in Sudan, adding "We need Turkey's economic experience."
