CANADA ISRAEL FREE TRADE AGREEMENT CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN INSTRUCTIONS

Purposes of obtaining preferential tariff treatment, this document must be completed legibly and in full by the exporter and be in the possession of the importer at the time the declaration is made. Please print or type.

- Field 1: State the full legal name and address (including country) of the exporter.
- Field 2: Complete field if the Certificate covers multiples shipments of identical goods as described in Field 5 that are imported into a CIFTA country for a specified period of up to one year (blanket period). "FORM" is the date upon which the Certificate becomes applicable to the good covered by the blanket Certificate (it may be prior to the date of signing this certificate). "TO" is the date upon which the blanket period expires. The importation of a good for which preferential tariff treatment is claimed based on this Certificate must occur between these dates.
- Field 3: State the full legal name and address (including country) cross referenced to the good described in Field 5. If you wish this information to be confidential, it is acceptable to state "Available to Customs upon request". If the producer and the exporter are the same, complete field with "SAME". If the producer is unknown, it is acceptable to state "UNKNOWN".
- Field 4: State the full legal name and address (including country) of the importer. If importer is not known, state "UNKNOWN"; if multiple importers, state "VARIOUS".
- Field 5: Provide a full description of each good. The description should be sufficient to relate it to the invoice description and to the Harmonized System (HS) description of the good. If the Certificate covers a single shipment of a good, i.e. it is not a blanket certificate, include the invoice number as shown on the commercial invoice. If not known, indicate another unique reference number, such as the shipping order number.
- Field 6: For each good described in Field 5, identify the HS tariff classification to six digits. If the good is subject to a specific rule of origin in Annex 3.1 that requires eight digits, identify to eight digits, using the HS tariff classification of the country into whose territory the good is imported.
- Field 7: For each good described in field 5, state which criterion (A through E) is applicable. The rules of origin are contained in Chapter Three and Annex 3.1.
- NOTE: In order to be entitled to preferential tariff treatment, each good must meet at least one of the criteria below.**

Preference Criteria

- A The good is "wholly obtained or produced entirely" in the territory of one or both of the parties, as referred to in Article 3.13. NOTE: The purchase of a good in the territory does not necessarily render it "wholly obtained or produced". (Reference: Article 3.1 (a) and 3.13).
- B The good is produced entirely in the territory of one or both of the parties and satisfies the specific rule of origin, set out in Annex 3.1, that applies to its tariff classification. The good must also satisfy all other applicable requirements of Chapter Three. (Reference: Article 3.1 (b)).
- C The good satisfies, as a result of production occurring entirely within the territory of one or both of the Parties, the applicable requirements set out in the rule of the good in Annex 3.1 where no change in tariff classification is required in that rule. (Reference Article 3.1 (c)).
- D The good is produced entirely in the territory of one or both of the parties exclusively from originating materials. Under this criterion, one or more of the materials may not fall within the definition of "wholly produced or obtained", as set out in Article 3.13. All materials used in the production of the good must qualify as "originating" by meeting the rules of Article 3.1 (a) through (e). (Reference Article 3.1 (d)).
- E Goods are produced in the territory of one or both of the parties but do not meet the applicable rule of origin, set out in Annex 3.1., because certain non-originating materials do not undergo the required change in tariff classification. The goods do nonetheless meet the production requirement specified in Article 3.1 (e). This criterion is applicable only where the good incorporated one or more non-originating materials, provided for as parts under the HS, which could not undergo a change in tariff classification because the heading provided for both the good and its parts and was not further subdivided into subheadings, or the subheading provided for both the good and its parts.
- NOTE: This criterion does not apply to Chapters 61 through 63 of the HS (Reference: Article 3.1 (e)).**
- Field 8: For each good described in Field 5, state "YES" if you are the producer of the good. If you are not the producer of the good, state "NO" followed by (1) or (2), depending on whether this certificate was based upon: (1) your knowledge of whether the good qualifies as an originating good or (2) your reliance on the producer's written representation that the good qualifies as an originating good.
- Field 9: Where the certificate is not a blanket certificate indicate the gross weight or number of pieces in the shipment.
- Field 10: This field must be completed, signed and dated by the exporter. The date must be the date the Certificate was completed and signed.
