What is the EU Trade Helpdesk?

- A website on how to export to the EU
- A source of information on EU import duties, product requirements, rules of origin, internal taxes and trade statistics
- A database on trade in goods
- Usable free of charge, without registration formalities



Types of data

What can you find on the Trade Helpdesk website?



EU product requirements for goods imported to or circulating on the EU single market (health, safety, technical standards, marketing standards)



EU custom duties, duty discounts, quota database



How to benefit from reduced duties – the rules and proofs of origin according to trade agreements or preferential schemes



Who to contact for advice

Competent authorities, customs offices, chambers of commerce in EU countries



Trade statistics

All recent trade flows – product by product, country by country

How to access EU data for your product?



- Go to tradehelpdesk.europa.eu
- Fill in the exporting and importing country and the product you intend to export to the EU; if needed, click on "find your product code" and browse the "tree" of classification codes to find the correct code for your product
- 3. Click on "view rates and requirements"





1st tab: import procedures

Three types of information:

- 1. Information on the EU's import procedures
- 2. The main documents you need for customs clearance
- 3. Import formalities and competent authorities for the EU country you have defined as importing country

EU data for your product

2nd tab: product requirements

The list of EU requirements applying to your product.

These documents explain each requirement and link to the **EU law** it is based on.

They also include

- specific certificates you may need,
- the competent authorities in the importing country,
- More information relating to the importing country, e.g. specific labelling or packaging provisions.







3rd tab: import duties

 The first row shows the import duty exporters from non-EU countries should generally pay



- The following rows show which duty discount you can claim for your product according to either
 - the Generalized System of Preferences the EU grants to lower-middle income countries, or
 - a trade agreement signed between the country you are exporting from and the European Union
- This tab will also show you any quota or antidumping duties






4th tab: internal taxes

The internal taxes for your product in the EU importing country you selected.

This information includes:

- Value-Added-Tax (VAT)
- Excise duty applying to alcoholic beverages, manufactured tobacco products and energy products, e.g. motor and heating fuels

Note that internal taxes are not harmonised in the EU and hence they vary from one country to another.








5th tab: rules of origin

If your product can benefit from a duty discount this tab will show you the conditions, i.e. the rules of origin for your product.



These rules describe how "originating status" is determined in the agreement or preferential scheme in place.

You will find more information relating to the rules of origin of a specific agreement, e.g. the "cumulation" provisions and the "proofs of origin" in the Trade Helpdesk Website section "Rules of Origin".





6th tab: trade statistics

- If your product is already imported into the European Union you may check the trade flows between the exporting and importing country.
- To find all trade flows between non-EU countries and the European Union please go to section "Statistics" on the Trade Helpdesk Website.



Overview: What is the EuroMed Trade Helpdesk?

An online helpdesk containing free information needed to do business in the Euro-Mediterranean region



Market access data and trade data covering 9 partner countries



Objectives of the EuroMed Trade Helpdesk

To facilitate closer economic ties between EU and Southern Mediterranean countries and among southern Mediterranean countries themselves by:

Developing a *public online information portal with helpdesk service*containing information on trade and market access conditions



Establishing a network of technical focal points from relevant national institutions who will respond to enquiries.



EuroMed Trade Helpdesk helps you answer the important questions



What are the *tariffs and market access requirements* that apply to my product and country?



What are the necessary *import procedures* to trade with the destination country?



What are the *trade flows and market demand trends* in the 9 partner countries?



What are the *companies* importing the products I sell?



Advantages of the EuroMed Trade Helpdesk

 - ➤ Powered by other established databases of ITC: Trade Map and Market Access Map
 - ➤ Direct validation from national authority
- Fully adapted to the 9 partners: data and language (structure & support materials available in English, French, Arabic and Turkish)
- Free for all users thanks to financial support from the European Union and other donors to ITC Trust Funds
- Practical information such as company, institution contact information and step-by-step guide for importers



Breadth of the information

CUSTOMS TARIFFS AND TRADE REGIMES:

- >Import tariffs (MFN or general tariff) from most current year
- Any preferential tariffs granted bilaterally, regionally and to all trading partners
- ➤ Rules of Origin* for preferential arrangements as well as downloadable Certificate of Origin
- >Trade Remedies*: countervailing (e.g subsidies) & antidumping duties; safeguards (import surges)

PRODUCT SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS:

- Food safety and animal and plant health regulations (SPS)
- Compulsory technical regulations (performance, labelling, size/shape, design, function of products)
- ➤ Product specific excise taxes

TRADE STATISTICS:

>Annual and monthly statistics reported by each country at detailed product level – the national tariff line by bilateral partner country

GENERAL COMPULSORY REQUIREMENTS:

- ➤ Trade Procedures
- ➤Internal Taxes (e.g. VAT/sales tax & excise duties)

BUSINESS CONTACTS:

➤ Institutions; customs and taxation authorities; chambers of commerce; industry associations; relevant online marketplaces; and event organizing bodies

NEWS:

Any announcements, newsletters and events that national focal points may wish to advertise

Market Information: Market Access



- Tariff rates and internal taxes applied by importer on exporter
- Trade agreements, preferential tariffs and rules of origin
- Additional taxes and price control measures (summaries, institutions in charge & support documentation)

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COMPULSORY REQUIREMENTS

- Product specific requirements applied by target country
- Product specific requirements applied by exporting country
- Requirements applied by target countries to all imported goods

★ TRADE STATISTICS ◆

- Existing trade between two countries for the product
- Trade flows direction
- Trade indicators, provides information on import and export values, five years growth rates & market shares
- Deep links to Trade Map for time series data and graphical outputs & destination markets
- Source of data (direct or mirror)





EuroMed Trade Helpdesk User enquiry system





The enquiry facility focuses on questions related to <u>trade data</u> and to <u>publicly available</u> <u>information on trade regulations and procedures</u>

It should avoid issues relating to disputes between economic operators or of a trade policy nature as there are

other mechanisms for handling such problems.




