



#### **Industrial Production sold**










Gross domestic product (GDP) of AUSTRIA at current prices increased by € 8.7 bn, or 3.1%, to approximately € 310 bn in 2012.

Hence, nominal GDP per inhabitant amounted to € 36.640 (+2.4%).



### GDP per capita in USD 2011 (PPP)




TOP-10 in the EU, 2012 (GDP per capita, PPS) in EUR






### **Austrian Exports (in goods)**








### **Unemployment, total (% of labor force)**






# Labor participation rate (% of total population, ages 15+)






#### Hourly productivity in the manufacturing industry

GDP per person employed per hour, in US\$ (Source: World Competitiveness Yearbook, 2010)




#### Unit labor costs in the manufacturing industry

Changes 1999-2009 in % (Source: European Commission)




### Logistics infrastructure


### Inflation rate, consumer price (annual %)




### **R&D** expenditure (% of GDP)






# Reasearch and Development spending per capita






### AUSTRIAN DIRECT INVESTMENT ABROAD END OF 2011: 153,6 BN EUR



# LOAN MARKET SHARE OF AUSTRIAN BANK SUBSIDIARIES IN CESEE COUNTRIES 2011






### Population growth in Austria and Israel






# Bilateral Trade Development (EUR) Austria - Israel






**Austrian Exports to Israel 2012**


### **Austrian Imports from Israel 2012**




### **Israeli tourists in Austria (in thousands)**
