- 1. The Ethiopian Agricultural Transformation Agency (ATA) is an initiative of the Government of Ethiopia (GOE) established by federal regulation. The formation of the ATA is a result of two years of extensive diagnostic study across eight subsectors of Ethiopia's agricultural system in a highly-consultative, multi stakeholder process lead by the Ministry of Agriculture with the support of the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.
- The agency has funds and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this fund to payments under the Contract for the procurement of services.
- 3. The Agricultural Transformation Agency now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the procurement of service.
- Consultancy Services in Assessment of market linkage opportunities in the horticultural value chain.
- 4. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the open tendering procedures contained in the Public Procurement Proclamation of the Government of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia. Bidding is open to all Bidders from eligible source countries.

Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at the address below at 10:30 A.M. on September 9, 2013.
